Belle Heller <i>Catawbiense Album x catawbiense seedling</i> Flower white with a large golden blotch.	3m	M	3

Buna <i>Yaku Sunrise x Lems Cameo:</i> Rich biscuity-yellow flowers open from peachy cream buds. Very floriferous. Well formed trusses of very open, star like flowers. Dense mounding habit and deep green foliage. A fantastic plant.	1.2m	M	5

Cinnamon Bear <i>bureavii x yakushmanum Koichiro Wada</i> This plant is probably the finest foliage plant you can find. Masses of soft cinnamon indumentum. Tight round trusses of pure white follow a light pink bud.	60cm	M	8

Cream Crest <i>rupicola var. chryseum x Cilpinense</i> Alpine. An upright plant with small leaves that bear beautiful dainty cream flowers. Leaves very glossy and deep green. Spreading habit.	1m	E	11

Cream Supreme <i>Colonel Cohen x unknown</i> Apricot buds open to cream flowers with some pink flares on the outer lobes. Bright green gold speckling on the upper lobe. Very delicate in appearance but actually quite robust.	1.2m	L	13
Creamy Chiffon <i>unknown x unknown</i> Flower semi-double, wavy edges, creamy apricot with some pinkish shading, fades to pale greenish yellow.	1.2m	L	14
Cunningham's White <i>caucasicum x ponticum</i> Opens white with a pale yellow eye. Will grow almost anywhere, including sunny spots. Flowers are yellowish white and profusely cover the dwarf plant. Habit is tidy and compact with attractive foliage, great hedging plant.	1.5m	L	15
Dora Amateis <i>minus var minus Carolinianum Group x ciliatum</i> Pure white flowers with faint greenish-yellow spotting on dorsal lobe. Low growing bushy plant that will stand full sun.	1m	M	16
Elsie Frye <i>ciliicalyx hybrid</i> Beautiful sweet fragrance is carried by these thick waxy like flowers. Pink buds open to white flowers with creamy yellow centres and some apple blossom pink on the outside of the flowers. Very vigorous.	1.2m	E	17

Lem's Monarch <i>Anna x Marinus Koster</i> This plant is very easy to recommend, it is hardy, floriferous and has a good habit. Makes a fantastic long lasting display in flower. Strong pink buds open to white flowers edged with soft pink.	1.2m	L	31
Loders White <i>arboreum ssp cinnamomeum var album x griffithianum</i> A large dome shaped shrub, covered to the ground in handsome foliage. Flowers in a magnificent conical truss, with pale pink buds opening to white, slightly frilly flowers.	1.5m	M	32
Melody <i>yakushmanum x leo</i> Predominantly white flowers with a pale pink edging that is frilled.	1.2m	M	33
Mi Amor <i>lindleyi x nuttallii</i> Strong perfume. Large white flowers with flushed yellow throat. Heavily textured leaves. Vigorous growing and a little open in habit. One of our most popular fragrant rhodos. Protect buds from heavy frost.	1.5m	M	34
Mount Everest <i>possibly campanulatum, griffithianum and catawbiense</i> Prolific producer of white flowers with a little red brown speckling in the throat. One of our most popular white rhodos.	1.2m	M	35
Mrs Tom Lowinsky Rounded compact plant. Flowers blush to white with striking orange brown flare.	2m	L	36
Pawhuska <i>Palmer x Loderi King George</i> Showy white flowers appear from a hint of blush buds. Tall trusses, large glossy green foliage.	2m	M	37
Phyllis Korn <i>Diane x Gomer Waterer</i> Upright, well branched grower. Large flowers soft cream with a touch of red in the throat.	1.5m	L	38
Platinum Ice <i>augustinii x maddenii</i> Ice blue buds that open to large white flowers. Heavily textured large flowers.	1.8m	L	39
Point Defiance <i>Anna x Marinus Koster</i> A clone from Halfdan Lem's Walloper group. Its large succulent flowers have pink edges which become lighter pink then white in the flower centre. Attractive, dark green leaves, make this a plant to remember.	2m	M	40

Princess Alice <i>edgeworthii x ciliatum</i> A compact plant with pale pink buds opening to white flowers, intensely fragrant. Needs to be sheltered from frost.	1m	M	43
Sappho <i>unknown</i> Flowers mauve in bud, opening to pure white with a conspicuous blotch of rich purple-black. Very beautiful and very popular; this one goes quickly.	2m	M	44
Sapporo <i>Hachmann's Diadem x Hyperion</i> Flower broadly funnel-shaped, wavy-edged, opens pale purple tinged purplish-pink on veins especially on outside with a deep purplish-red blotch. Quickly fades to white with age.	1.5m	M	45
Silver Sixpence Upright, rounded, evergreen shrub with deep green leaves. In late spring to early summer it has creamy, trumpet flowers that have attractive yellow spot.	1m	M	46
Sleepy <i>degronianum ssp yakushmanum x Doncaster</i> Flowers open rosy pink in bud but fade to white.	1m	M	47
Snow Lady <i>leucaspsis x ciliatum</i> Nice compact plant with masses of creamy white flowers with brown stamens.	1m	E	48

Tanana <i>R. decorum ssp decorum x R. degronianum ssp yakushmanum Exbury Yakushmanum</i> Flowers, white with yellowish green spots.	1m	M	50
Tiana <i>Sappho x yakushmanum Exbury form</i> Lovely white butterfly shaped blooms with burgundy blotches. This plant has a compact growth habit with dark green foliage. Frilly edges make it different to Sappho. Another similar rhodo is Peeping Tom.	1.2m	M	51
Triumph de Grande Masses of huge big trusses of white flowers with red spotting on the upper lobe.	1.8m	M	52
Unique <i>camplyocarpum hybrid</i> Fantastic all round performer for flower and foliage. Beautiful buttery cream flowers smother the plant.	1.2m	M	53
White Gold <i>Mrs. J. G. Millais' x Cheyenne</i> The flowers are a pure stark white rolled back at the edges as if trying to show every inch of the golden blotch within. The blotch begins as a burning orange deep in the throat, then widens and lightens into rays of golden yellow reaching out onto the upper lobe.	1.5m	L	54
White Pearl <i>griffithianum x maximum</i> Pink buds opening to pure white, giving a delightful two tone effect. Good pleasing foliage cover this plant which is vigorous and ultimately large growing.	2m	M	55
White Swan <i>decorum x Pink Pearl</i> Huge perfect flowers of satin white are exceptionally showy. Tall growing with tough grey green foliage. One of the best whites.	2m	M	56
Yak Angel <i>form of yakushmanum ssp. Yakushmanum</i> A dwarf plant with a spreading growth habit that is wider than tall. Deep green leaves have brown indumentum, with new growth white-tomentose. Mauve pink buds open to white flowers.	75cm	M	57
Yak Pac Walport A selection of yakushmanum pacysanthum. A pure white flower. Very compact grower, with heavy cinnamon indumentum on new growth. Looks fantastic all year.	1m	L	58
